Homework 2 – Sequence Compositing

Description

Use Shake to create a composited image sequence depicting footage of a story worthy of printing in the “Weekly World News” tabloid. For example, you may create a story of Bat Boy in Las Vegas. Your sequence should adhere to the following guidelines:

- duration: 20-30 s
- input footage: live-action background (shot by you) and one of the following
 - live-action foreground (shot by you)
 - computer-generated foreground (created by you)
- explanation: add subtitles or a voice-over in reporter-style format to explain the story

Please be creative with the story and sequence you produce. Try to make the final image to appear as if it were created with a single camera.

Submission Requirements

You should create a web page with the following:

- your name, the date, and a title/description of this project
- a visual chronology of the project:
 - idea drawings
 - sample shots from original footage or of CG elements
 - matte images
 - final images
 - a link to the final movie

We will view (and critique) the sequences in class. Your grade will be based on the quality of your composited work.
