1. Use `jot` to create the "hello, world!" program discussed in class. Name your program `hello.c`
2. Compile `hello.c` with the `cc` command, naming the executable file `hello`
3. Run `hello`
4. Run `hello` saving the output to a file called `hello.txt` (use redirection through the `>` operator)
5. Make a copy of `hello.c` in a file called `address.c`
6. Modify `address.c` to print out your name, address, e-mail, and phone number. For example,  

```
Tim Davis  
437 Edwards Hall  
Clemson University  
Clemson, SC 29642  
  
tadavis@cs.clemson.edu  
  
(864) 656-0309
```
7. Save the output in a file called `address.txt`
